

Privacy Statement

Protecting your privacy is important to us. We promise to respect and safeguard your personal information. We shall try to ensure that your details are accurate and kept up to date. We set out below how we use this information.

We collect and use personal information to allow us to give you a quote or process your purchase of a policy and also for claim administration. Such information may include your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, as well as your credit or debit card number and expiry date.

IPP is committed to protecting your privacy and takes its responsibilities regarding security of customer information very seriously. We use one of the best available security systems to protect your communication with us.

As your details are sent to us they are encrypted using a system called Secure Socket Layer, (SSL 128bit). You will see a padlock symbol at the bottom of the screen to confirm this.

Secure socket layers serve three purposes.....

It prevents impersonation so you can be certain you are dealing with IPP,

- * It encrypts data so that others cannot read it.
- * It prevents others changing data that is being sent.

In addition your data is stored behind a firewall on our internal systems; this prevents unauthorised people from gaining access to it.

Furthermore, as required by the UK Data Protection Act 1998, we follow strict security procedures in the storage and disclosure of information which you have given us to prevent unauthorised access.
